Directions to Show Site:

From Route 84, (NY&PA), use Milford Exit. Rte. 6 East to Rte. 209 South. Cross Bridge, Rte. 206. Follow Rte. 206 into Andover Boro staying on Route 206 go under the long RR tunnel Morris Sussex Pike is the first right after the Shell Gas Station – go under small RR trestle and make the immediate right turn into the driveway of the school.

From Route 80, use Exit 25 – Route 206 North – travel Rte 206 Thru 4 traffic lights – after going through 4th light , Morris Sussex Pike is the third left turn (you will be turning just prior to the Shell Gas Station) go under small RR trestle and make the immediate right turn into the driveway of the school

Parking must be in the school parking lot. Limited crate space, may work out of cars.

Notice to Competitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of APDT Rally Obedience rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- ◆ This trial is open to all dogs being at least six months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.
- ◆ All dogs must be registered with APDT Rally to compete. Registration information can be obtained directly from APDT at www.apdt.com/RallyO.
- ◆ A member of the owner's immediate family must show dogs: mother, father, spouse, life partner, sibling, child, grandparent, or grandchild.
- ◆ Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- ◆ The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.

In addition,

- ◆ THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. There will be no refunds if the trial has to be cancelled for any reason.
- ◆ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.
- ◆ No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- ◆ All dogs shall be shown in a flat buckle or snap collar, plain harness, or properly fitted martingale (limited slip) collar. No choke collars, prong collars, shock collars, no-pull harnesses, martingale leads, or head collars are allowed.
- ◆ All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast, and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the APDT or the trial host(s).
- ◆ Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.
- ◆ Upon successful completion of an exercise, the owner may choose to briefly pet or touch the dog as a reward. The owner may also choose to give the dog food as a reward. Food may NOT be used as a lure to help the dog complete an exercise. Food rewards must be contained in pockets or hidden treat pouches and only be present in the owner's hand in between exercises. Any petting, touching, or feeding that significantly interrupts the flow of performance shall be scored accordingly.
- ◆ Dogs must remain under control at all times whether on or off leash while on show grounds. Day kenneling only is permitted, unless otherwise posted at the show site. Crates may be left overnight at your own risk.
- ◆ Please pick up after your dog and yourself.
- ◆ This event will be indoors on rubber matting.. There will be limited crate space, you may work out of your cars.

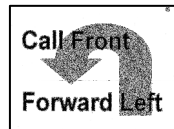
Rally-O is a sport, which consists of a sequence of numbered stations, heeled to by a handler and dog, where a sign at each station indicates an obedience exercise, which the team must perform. Rally is designed to be more relaxed than precision competitive Obedience, focusing instead on attitude and enthusiasm, while the variety of exercises and courses allows you to show off your versatility and teamwork. Rally is intended to promote positive relationships between dogs and owners based on trust and mutual respect. Dogs and handlers should both appear to be enjoying the competition and each other's company.

APDT Rally encourages participation by ALL dogs – purebred or mixed breed, pets or titled champions. Handlers are allowed to encourage their dogs in the ring using verbal praise, petting, and even food rewards just as they would in a good training session. The dogs must perform the exercises correctly and should be a practiced smooth flow to the performance.

Rally courses, depending on the competition level, consist of 18 to 22 stations, laid out in a numbered pattern (like an agility course) and performed on-leash in Level 1 or off-leash in Levels 2 and 3 (Level 1 title is required to compete at Level 2 and a Level 2 title is required to compete in Level 3). Also like agility, handlers get to walk the course and familiarize themselves with the pattern without their dog before running the course. During their run, the dog and handler move through the course in heel position, performing each exercise in turn.

There are as many as 60 different exercises, which might be seen in a Rally course, primarily variations on basic heel exercises and other Obedience skills. Many of the stations involve activities you are probably familiar with; such as Slow/Normal/Fast Pace, Halt, Left/Right/About Turn, and Finish Right/Left. Others are simple extensions, such as 270° and 360° Right/Left Turns, Straight Figure Eight, and Send over Jumps. A few of the other interesting stations include:

- *Call Front - Forward Left:* the handler stops his forward motion and calls the dog to the front position, then moves forward while commanding the dog to move left into heel position falling into step with the handler.
- *Halt - 1, 2, 3 Steps Forward:* After a halt, the handler takes one step forward, halts, 2 steps, halts, 3 steps and halts. The dog heels with the handler and sits each time the handler halts.
- *Spiral Right:* The handler, with dog in heel, makes a sequence of right turns around a line of 3-4 pylons, with the first two turns around the end pylons and each successive turn on one end getting tighter and tighter.



You must be familiar with all of the different Rally-O exercise signs prior to the event. Attention First Time APDT Rally Competitors:

All dogs must be registered with APDT Rally to compete. A one-time registration form is on page 4 and must be submitted DIRECTLY to the RallyO Coordinator address on the form (NOT to GRSFD) before the date that a team first competes in a sanctioned trial. **You must have your registration number prior to entering the trials; no pending numbers will be accepted.**

Any changes to entries, including cancellations, will be accepted until Jan. 15, 2010. Changes must be made to the Secretary in writing; by e-mail or mail. Any changes requested after Jan. 15th up to and including the day of trial, will be subject to a \$20.00 processing fee, payable day of trial. Cancellations received after Jan. 15, 2010 will not be eligible for a refund.

Entries and Closing Date

Entries will open Monday, November 1, 2010

Entries must be received by **Jan 15, 2010** at 7:00 PM. Entries submitted via Federal Express or Express Mail will be accepted only if the signature waiver is signed. No telephone, e-mail, or fax entries will be accepted. Confirmations will be sent, preferably by email, after the closing date.

Any changes to entries, including cancellations, will be accepted until Jan. 15, 2010.. Changes must be made to the Secretary by e-mail, or in writing. Cancellations received after Jan. 15, 2010 will not be eligible for a refund of fees. Move ups from Class A to Class B are permitted after the closing date until walk thru for class moving to.

Weather

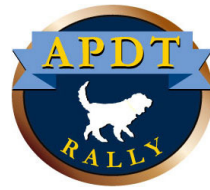
This trial will be held indoors on rubber matting.. No refunds will be given for bad weather.

Judging schedule for Trial 2 will be Level 3, followed by Level 2, followed by Level 1. Trial 3 check in will be 9 am with walk through and judges briefing at 9:30 am. Judging schedule will be Level 1, followed by Level 2, followed by Level 3.
